uestions to ponder/discuss:
1. What is this passage revealing about God and what is it revealing about us as humans?
2. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?
3. What is the importance of Jesus being a priest in heaven?
4. Verses 7-13 contrast the old and new covenants. a. Why was the new covenant necessary? What was wrong with the old covenant?
b. Take time and list differences that the author lists between the two covenants
c. Who is doing the action for this new covenant?
d. What is our (humanity's) role in the new covenant?

Experiential

Sometimes activities help us to understand and process biblical truths. The ones below are suggestions for how to experience the truths of Hebrews 2. Feel free to use one of these or any you might come up with.

Shadow puppets

Set up an area on a wall where you can play shadow puppets. Take turns using your shadows to make shapes, pictures and animals and the others can try to guess what you are making. Afterwards, talk about the experience and compare it to Hebrews 8:5 which refers to copies and shadows. How does playing this game increase your understanding of this verse? Think of other "shadows" that are part of life that are ultimately fulfilled in Christ alone. List as many as you can and be ready to share these with others as you go this week.
