READ Revelation 3: 1-6

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What is this passage revealing about God and what is it revealing about us as humans?
- 2. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?
- 3. Jesus says he will come like a thief. Look at the other areas of scripture where this simile is used.
 - a. Revelation 16:15
 - b. Matthew 24:43
 - c. 1 Thessalonians 5:2
 - d. 2 Peter 3:10
 - e. How does reading these other scriptures help you better understand these words to the Christians in Sardis?
- 4. Jesus references a "book of life" in verse 5. Look up these other references to find out more about this book.
 - a. Revelation 13:8, 17:8, 20:12 & 15, 21:27
 - b. Philippians 4:3
 - c. Exodus 32:32
 - d. Psalm 69:28
 - e. Isaiah 4:3
 - f. Daniel 12: 1-2
- 5. Read Revelation 7: 9-17. What insight does this give you about those who "will be clothed thus in white garments" (v5).
