

Dig Deeper @Home – "Gather. Nurture. Make Disciples." Complement to sermon on October 22, 2017 – "Point to Christ"

MEMORIZE – Galatians 5: 5-6

For through the Spirit, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love.

READ Galatians 3: 15-29

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What is this passage revealing about God and what is it revealing about us as humans?

2. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?

3. What is the point Paul wants to make about covenants (promises) that people make between themselves (i.e. legal documents like wills) and the covenant God made with Abraham? (3:15, also 3:8)

4. In Verse 17, Paul says the law does not do away with the promise; so what is the purpose of the law? (see vv. 19 and 23) Can you identify both a negative and positive purpose? Read Romans 3:19-20

5. How does the law help us see our sin? How does the law prepare us for grace?

6. How is relating to God through keeping the law like being kept in prison (v. 23) or like being supervised by a guardian? (vs. 25)

6. What is the relationship between faith and obedience? Read James 2:14-26. How do you reconcile Paul's words about justification by faith with James' words about faith and works?

Bottom Line – Summarize Galatians 3: 15-29 in your own words
