ICE BREAKER – ask these to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. What was your high and low of the week?
- 2. What's your favorite piece of clothing to wear? (answer could be specific ie my cream sweater or generic ie hoodies)

MEMORIZE – Ephesians 4: 15-16

Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every point with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love.

READ – Read Ephesians 5:18 – 6:8

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What does this passage reveal about God? About humanity?
- 2. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life?
- 3. What is the connection between submission and giving thanks? (hint: v18-21)
- 4. What is to be our motivation for submitting to one another? (hint: it is not whether the person deserves it or not)
- 5. Paul gives three examples of submission: husbands and wives, parents and children, masters and slaves.
 - a. What is the common thread throughout these three examples?
 - b. What is challenging about these examples?
 - c. How well do you do personally living these out daily in your own life? Identify areas you do well and areas where you don't do so well.
 - i. Take time to confess the areas you fall short and to receive God's grace through Christ

Summarize Ephesians 5:1-20 in your own words:

Experiential: The Discipline of Submission

Submission can often be viewed as weak or negative. But the Bible paints a very different picture. Jesus himself says that he only speaks what the Father tells him to (John 8:28, 12:49). Spend time this week practicing the discipline of submission and journaling about it. How did you feel? Were you able to? What made it difficult? What made it easy?
