MEMORIZE – John 10: 14-16

READ Luke 15:1-10

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What sticks out to you in this passage?
1. What sticks out to you in this passage:
2. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
3. What is this passage revealing about God?
 What is this passage revealing about God?

- 4. What is it revealing about us as humans?
- 5. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?
- 6. Who is in Jesus' audience? How do they respond to him?
- 7. How does Jesus' parables of the sheep and the coin relate to the "muttering" of the Pharisees?

EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY - LOST COIN HUNT

Have a member of your group hide a coin in a designated area and the rest of the group can search high and low for the coin. The person hiding the coin can say several times NOT TO GIVE UP and they will continue to search. If coin is not found right away, the one hiding the coin can say they are getting hot or cold to point the rest of the group in the right direction. After several turns of hiding the coin, discuss about how Jesus doesn't give up on us when we are lost. How does this compare to how God pursues us?
