READ John 14:1-7

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What sticks out to you in this passage?
- 2. What did you like? What didn't you like?
- 3. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
- 4. Which person do you most identify with in these passages and why?
- 5. What is this passage revealing about God?
- 6. What is it revealing about us as humans?
- 7. In light of John 14:6, how would you respond to someone who says, "there are many ways to God"?
