### **READ Luke 6**

uestions to ponder/discuss:	
1.	What sticks out to you in this passage? What did you like? What didn't you like?
2.	What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
3.	What is this passage revealing about God? About us as humans?
4.	Read again Luke 6: 27-36. What makes these directives from Jesus difficult to live out? What can you do this week to live them out more fully?

- 5. What is so important about Jesus declaring "out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks?"
  - a. How does this relate to the "log that is in your own eye?" (Luke 6:41)
  - b. How do we get the log out of our eye after we recognize it?

## Experiential activity – Show me, Grow me

It is humbling to realize that we all have logs in our eyes and hearts that are set on evil. Even more humbling, we often can't see either of these realities in our lives. Instead, we point out other people's faults and shortcomings. This is what Jesus is calling out in Luke 6: 37-45. Do you want that log revealed and removed? Do you want that dead heart transformed to a living one? Spend time this week praying this simple prayer: Holy Spirit...show me and grow me. Show me the log in my own eye. Reveal the things in me that are contrary to your ways. Then, Holy Spirit grow me. Remove the log from my eye. Help me to see clearly. Remove the callouses on my heart and make it alive that your goodness would flow through it. Jesus told these parables for transformation. If you want to be transformed, it begins with you praying to God ... Show me and Grow me.
