ICE BREAKER — Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. Are you more of a cup is half-empty or cup is half-full kind of person?
- 2. Would you rather be able to walk on water or walk through fire?

MEMORIZE – Philippians 1: 9-11

And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and discernment, so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

READ Philippians 1:27 – 2:11

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What sticks out to you in this passage? What did you like? What didn't you like?
- 2. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
- 3. What is this passage revealing about God? About us as humans?
- 4. In 1:27 Paul instructs the Philippians to "let their manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ."
 - a. The phrase "manner of life" literally means to "live as citizens."
 - i. What citizenship does Paul have in mind here? Is he telling the Philippians to live as citizens of Rome? If not, citizens of what? What does this mean to Christians living in 2020?
 - b. Take time to talk about what the gospel of Christ is. (for how can we live worthy of something if we are unable to define it)
 - c. What does it mean to live worthy of the gospel (hint: Paul gives some examples in verses 27-30)
 - d. What is the ultimate goal of a citizen focused on the gospel of Christ? (hint: check out 2: 10-11)
