ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

MEMORIZE – Habakkuk 3: 17-19

Though the fig tree should not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines, the produce of the olive fail and the fields yield no food, the flock be cut off from the fold and there be no herd in the stalls; yet I will rejoice in the LORD; I will take joy in the GOD of my salvation. GOD, the Lord, is my strength; he makes my feet like the deer's; he makes me tread on high places

READ Habakkuk 1:12 – 2:1

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What sticks out to you in this passage? What did you like? What didn't you like?
- 2. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated, contrasted, or compared?
- 3. What is this passage revealing about God? About us as humans?
- 4. 1:16 says, "Therefore he sacrifices to his net and makes offerings to his dragnet; for by them he lives in luxury, and his food is rich." In other words, they made sacrifices to the thing that made them wealthy. What allows you to live in luxury? How might you be making sacrifices to it?
- 5. In verse 12 Habakkuk asks, "Are you not from everlasting?" The Psalmist uses a similar phrase in Psalm 90. Read Psalm 90. What connections can you make from Psalm 90 to Habakkuk?

Experiential activity – "Hooked, Caught & Gathered"

This is what the wicked foe does ... hooks, catches and gathers. (vs. 15) This wicked foe, Babylon, was unwittingly hooked, caught and gathered by an even more insidious, wicked foe ... the god of much. As an exercise in the week ahead, ask God to show you where you might be currently hooked, caught or gathered by the god of much. As you do so, write them down. Share these "God sightings" with a trusted friend or family members. Ask God to work a work in you, freeing you from this god of much and filling you instead with his word or a song of praise. You may find yourself being astounded at the ways you have been able to see God at work.
