

Dig Deeper @Home – "Questions to Consider" Complement to lesson on 10/31/21 – "Can You Endure?"

ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. Would you rather travel into outer space or deep underwater?
- 2. Share about a time that you quit, when you couldn't endure. What was it and why did you quit?

MEMORIZE – Nahum 1:7

"The LORD is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; he knows those who take refuge in him."

READ – Nahum 1

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What does the Holy Spirit draw your attention to as you read these passages? What sticks out to you?
 - a. What details do you see? What details are left out?
 - b. Is anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
- 2. How do these passages bear witness about Jesus?
- 3. How can the LORD be on one hand vengeful, jealous and wrathful (v1) and on the other hand slow to anger (v3), good and a stronghold in the day of trouble (v7)? How do you reconcile these together? (hint: these are definitely reconcilable attributes)
- 4. In verses 4 and 5 we see creation's response to the LORD. Compare and contrast this with humanity's response to the LORD as depicted in v9.
- 5. Read Matthew 11: 28-30. How does this connect with Nahum 1: 12-13?

EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – Endurance Test

You have two options for this activity, one physical and one observational. You can choose to do one of them or both of them.

- 1. Physical Activity
 - a. Get into a plank position and try to hold it for 10 minutes or try to do 200 pushups in a row.
 - b. Questions: Were you able to do it?
- 2. Observational Activity
 - a. Boil water. Put an ice cube in it. Watch what happens.
 - b. Questions: Was the ice cube able to endure?
- 3. Overall question: How does this relate to the verses from Nahum 1?
