READ Colossians 1: 15-23

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What sticks out to you in this passage? What did you like? What didn't you like?
- 2. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
- 3. What is this passage revealing about God? About us as humans?
- 4. Write down all the descriptions of Jesus stated in these verses.
 - a. Which description draws your attention most?
 - b. Do any surprise you?
 - c. Which description do you need to learn more about?
- According to these verses, what is the purpose of Jesus reconciling you into his body?
 a. What are apprentices called to continue in?
 - i. What does this look like in your life?

Experiential activity – Learning "so as to"

In Colossians 1:10 Paul summarizes the point of being filled with knowledge of God's will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding. We do this "so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord," "to bear fruit in every good work" and to "increase in the knowledge of God." Of these three, where do you need to grow the most as an apprentice? Spend time in prayer and create an apprenticeship plan outlining what learning you need to accomplish, how you will do this learning, and what it will look like for you to apply your learning. Here's an example for your reference.
