ICE BREAKER — Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. What's your favorite thing to do on a frigid, cold day?
- 2. What kind of music helps you relax?

MEMORIZE – Philippians 4:9

What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me – practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.

READ Colossians 2:16-3:17

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What sticks out to you in this passage? What did you like? What didn't you like?
- 2. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
- 3. What is this passage revealing about God? About us as humans?
- 4. According to verses 16-19, what kind of judgement are Christians not to allow passed on them?
 - a. Why not?
- 5. In 2:20-23, Paul talks about submitting to elemental spirits.
 - a. What are elemental spirits?
 - b. What is the attraction to submitting to them?
 - c. Why does Paul say they are useless?

Experiential activity – Take Off, Put On

In Colossians 3: 5-14 Paul lists things that apprentices of Jesus are to take off and things that apprentices of Jesus are to put on.

- 1. Write out the list of things to take off
- 2. Write out the list of things to put on
- 3. On the list to take off, which one do you need to be most intentional at taking off this week?
- 4. On the list to put on, which one do you need to be most intentional at putting on this week?
- 5. What does an apprentice need to do in order to take the bad things off and put the good things on? Check out Colossians 3:1-4 for some help in answering this question.
