MEMORIZE

"if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land"
2nd Chronicles 7:14

READ

Read 2nd Chronicles 13-14

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What from the sermon stirred you the most?
2. How often do you recognize Jesus during the day? What could you do to recognize Him more?
3. DO you realize Christ's role in your life? How often do you talk about Jesus and what he has done/ or is doing? How often do you reflect on Him with your spouse, your children, your friends?
 - a. What benefit do you see in doing this more?
4. Maybe life is messy right now. How have you stopped fulfilling God's will in your life? What do you need to humbly confess to Jesus right now?

Bottom Line: When life gets messy, we have a loving Redeemer that we can turn to. When we do, when we humble ourselves before Him, we will know Him like we never have before.
