### **MEMORIZE**

# READ

Read 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles 7: 13-14, Matthew 6: 5-15

#### Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What from the sermon stirred you the most?
- 2. How often do you pray? Literally, how much time in a day do you spend praying? What is that saying about you?
- 3. What area of your life do you live most independently?
- 4. What do you need to do to become more dependent on Christ in that area? What does it look like to depend more on Jesus?
- 5. Maybe life is messy right now. Are you turning to Jesus with your messiness or trying to clean it all up on your own?
  - a. Take time and pray. Talk to Jesus. Lay it all out there.

**Bottom Line:** God wants us to depend on Him because He knows how much infinitely stronger and wiser He is than us.
