MEMORIZE

“if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land”
2nd Chronicles 7:14

READ

Read 2nd Chronicles 7: 13-14, Matthew 6: 5-15

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What from the sermon stirred you the most?
2. How often do you pray? Literally, how much time in a day do you spend praying? What is that saying about you?
3. What area of your life do you live most independently?
4. What do you need to do to become more dependent on Christ in that area? What does it look like to depend more on Jesus?
5. Maybe life is messy right now. Are you turning to Jesus with your messiness or trying to clean it all up on your own?
 - a. Take time and pray. Talk to Jesus. Lay it all out there.

Bottom Line: God wants us to depend on Him because He knows how much infinitely stronger and wiser He is than us.
