

Dig Deeper @Home – "True Community" Complement to sermon on 11/23/2025 – "Treated as Beloved"

ICE BREAKER — Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. When you were growing up, who was the person who made you feel most beloved. What do you remember them doing for you or with you?
- 2. Who is someone you know who displays humility? What actions in their life display humility?

MEMORIZE - 1st Peter 2:4

As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ

READ – 1 Peter 4:12 – 5:14

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. Re-scan the text and consider...
 - a. What did the Holy Spirit cause to "jump off the page" as you read?
 - b. What are the verses revealing about God?
 - c. What are the verses saying about people?
 - d. In light of these, what needs to change in your life? What are you already doing well?
- 2. Peter says to "clothe yourselves with humility" toward one another (1 Peter 5:5). What does this phrase mean practically?
- 3. What does it mean to "humble yourselves under God's mighty hand" (1 Peter 5:6)? How can you apply this in your daily life?
- 4. How does understanding that "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble" (1 Peter 5:5) influence your perspective and choices?

EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – Role-Playing Scenarios

In the group or as a family, present scenarios, such as winning a game or getting a good grade, or winning a prize or reaching a goal and have each person act out both a boastful and a humble response.

Discuss how the different responses would make others feel and why the humble response is a better choice. Read together, 1 Peter 5:5,6

Spend time worshipping together. Sing your own songs. Look songs up on YouTube for others to be able to sing along. Share a song that has been meaningful to you recently and talk about why. Make this time your own.
